

No. 1. *Botrichium simplex* ^{marginatum} Sterile segment
at or above the middle, nearly sessile

2. *B. ternatum*. Hairy; sterile segments
almost always 2, one from the preceding
year; short-stalked.

5. *Polypodium vulgare*, I think.
Segments very obtuse, sometimes
short and obovate.

7. *Aspidium* ^{Somewhat} ~~marginatum~~ var? Fronds
small, narrow; pinnæ many.

8. Same as 7? Fronds broader; rhachis
less chaffy.

9. *A. aculeatum* ^{aculeatum}? I collected this
with no 8, taking it for the same
thing, but it seems to belong to a
different species.

10. Probably this is *Leopodium annotinum*
but spikes often 2 together.

12 *Isoetes Bolanderi*? I have
specimens of *I. Bol.* from Mt. Paddo,
determined by Dr. Engelmann. This
plant seems to be a different thing
Leaves much longer and more slender.
