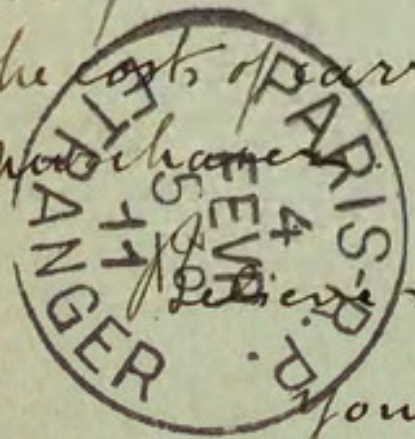


Charleville, Feb. 3 1911.
