Dear Collins,

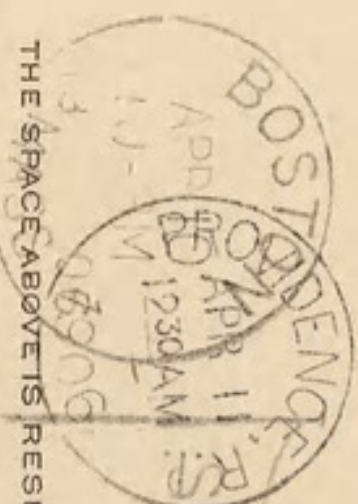
