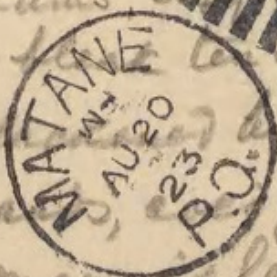


Ste Anne des Monts, Quebec

24 p.m. from Matane, containing 3000 sheets & packets
valued at 300 - 45 species new to Gaspe including
arctic and Rocky Mt. Carex, a Trox, Trache
Violas, more Senecios, Epilabium, As
Astragalus, etc. Fine luck but the leaves on
Tabletop; southern species all killed by freezing;
snow, sleet, blizzards, numb hands, cold feet, but
good alpine botanizing. In the morning leave for
Lyon again & other mts. on the Cap Chat -
