Dr. Asa Gray,

My Dear Sir:

Your kind letter of the 25th is received. I will be pleased to have you send my letter to the Am. Nat. If I had time I might extend my account by the addition of some minor particulars, but it is quite as well perhaps as it is. I think I made no mention of another "Notch" on the opposite side of the west base of Mansfield from Smuggler's Notch, distant from this some ten miles, where *Woodia*, *Robelia*, *Scirpus*, *argens*, *Astragalus alpinus*, etc., grow in precisely the same manner as in Smuggler's Notch.

In looking over more critically some *Woodia*s collected in Smuggler's Notch I find the same form as that gathered on the summit and sent you for *hyperborea*; and, as the material is ample and in better order,

I send the form again before that you may examine it yourself or send to Prof. Eaton. If you should still wish Mr. Eaton to see it, I will say you to send it to him direct, since I did send him specimens soon after gathering it, and have heard nothing from them. Perhaps I have not his full address. The younger fronds of this fern certainly show a good number of the spores, and some are quite complete, as you may see.

By the same mail I send you a little of such plants as you have requested, excepting *Saxifraga aizone* & *oppositifolia* and *Pinguicula*, which being past blooming I did not gather except in living plants to send to Mr. Sargent. After *gracilisifolia*, also, you will not find in the lot, but as I had seen it but a short time before at Willoughby with Mr. Cuyler, I think there can be no mistake about the plants I saw at Mansfield.
