My dear Dr. Standley:

I am sorry to be unable to help you with a list of the erchids of Salvader. My herbarium is very weak in its representation of Salvaderean material, although much stronger than any other through the collections made by your-self and Dr. Calderon. Schlechber reported only thirteen species from Salvader. I find that he refers to the following in the bedy of his compilation:

Sarcodlettis dutteresa (Reichb.f.) Ames. (Under Spiranthes)

Nelezia Partonii Norren.

Picurate that resolvence R. Br.

Concorn uninquenerals fais & Par. There is still sene doubt as to
the proper treatment of this. It is

Onoidium salvadorense Schlir.

Reason 270 in Mat. Feeb. = Stenerhynohus orchioides L.C. Rich. is from Selvador. (It might be well to return this for enother exemination.)

I will look through the collections here and hunt up some more specimens. I may have some additions to make.
