MEMORANDUM FOR Dr Ames

I am hurriedly sending to you this morning by registered mail (I received it about 10 minuted ago) preserved in a bottle, - one flower, and stem of buds, of the much desired Selenipedium chica, Reich.f. I would not take chances on the ~~others~~ flower remaining until the buds opened. This will give you a starter, and show you its manner of flowering. It seems to open in succession.

I am sure that more will follow later.

I have had to hurry this to watch the mail, which closes in $\frac{1}{2}$ hour for the States.
