Kennedy of Milton in the County of Norfolk, being the owner of the premises on the northerly side of Dudley Street, bounded easterly by land of the Boston Elevated Railway Company being the Dudley Street Station so called and on the west by the bank building, in consideration of the sum of \$964.50 to me paid by the Boston Elevated Railway Company do hereby release and discharge said Boston Elevated Railway Company from any claim to damages arising out of the injury to the brick building on my premises aforesaid done on August 4th, 1910 by the accident whereby a train of cars of said Company ran off the elevated tracks.
