At took to the bed and kept it while I struggled to dely the disease and shake it of and nt back to Jucson. It was a timble journey of thru days in weekness and suffering, but three houses in sixty miles and much of the road me travelled once a wisk. I barely held out to drive in. My mustfiver was dangerously high, 105%.

a good physician som substick the food; but my stungth is gone. I would not all much climbing in some time; and I don't want to rely any more on my half-imbails assistant. Field is wanting my help at hour to I have decided to return; though I sorrow not to have for you species for my new set, and to have certain forms and grasses especially.

Recently I have received a kind and entertaining letter from Mr. Higfinson, which I have not acqualled, because I have primitted the casts of
