Dinner is served like breakfast & by 7 P.M. I have to be in bed. This is on days when I cannot go out of doors. The weather is persistently ~~been~~ wet every day but one for the last 12 days. A swearing man would curse it up & down. On one day, last Monday, my boy hauled me out in the wheeled chair. I took 3 photographs, & in front so much that if I could get away day like that, or even  $\frac{1}{2}$ , I should be walking by this time. As it is, I can't walk 100 yds alone.
