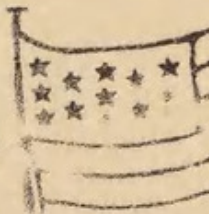
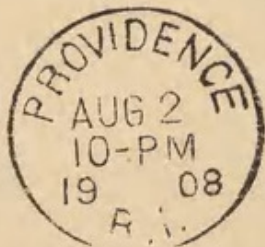


Providence, Aug 2^d, 1908
