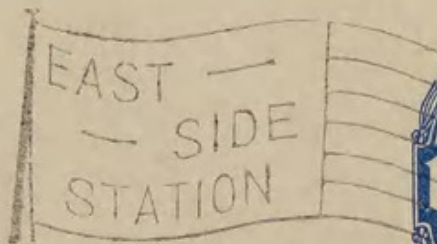


Providence - Oct 11, 1910
