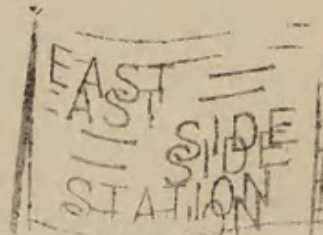
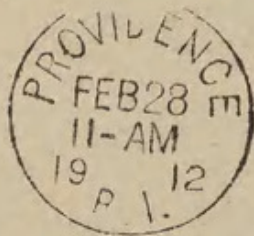


Dear Deane,
