of Amelanchier came in good condition
and I thank you very much for them.
The photographs were fine and I am glad to get
them, especially the one that contains such a
good picture of you. That tree is certainly
large.

The names on the labels are all right.
The mature leaves and young fruits of that supposed
hybrid still bear out my previous interpretation
that it is a hybrid between those two species.

I notice that Britton in his new illustrated
flora does not take up A. laevis ~~and~~ A. humilis
and A. stolonifera as good species. Part of the
difficulty in this case was probably due to the fact
that the illustrated flora was in type before my article
came out.
