Some species I have collected on a number of different occasions, and where I sent you all of a certain date that I had on hand, I have kept no farther record of it. I will have to ask you to return the labels I sent with the plants. As yet I have none of my flowering plants mounted. I have collected some eighty species of grasses here. Is it customary to write the last name in full on each label? The \$ 3.30 for carices is satisfactory. I should have written you sooner had I thought of needing the labels. Yours truly R. S.
