My Dear Deane: As soon as I rec'd your last letter, I wrote to a friend in Europe asking for the carices you want. *C. rotundata* does not occur in America south of Greenland. R. S. Williams, Great Falls, Montana, sends me, among other things, good specimens of *C. Torreyi*. But the most singular thing among carices is the appearance of *C. Pottiana* in Indiana! I have just received specimens. It is wonderful that it should be found there. They were found by my colleague, W. R. Dudley, and you may be able to get a specimen by writing him. This species is now *C. picta* Steud.
