I am wading thro' all the unnamed carices of Olney's collection, sent on from Brown. There are no labels, and no indication of where any of the specimens — with very rare exceptions — are from. They are the remnants from everywhere. You can imagine that it is a puzzling

job. Yet I have found two new species among  
them, and one at least I shall describe.  
There is not the least indication of date, country  
or collector! I want to give some name to  
indicate that it is known only in the herbar-  
ium, and had thought of Carex herbariorum.

Is not that a good genitive, as good as  
C. pinetorum and C. ericetorum?
