No. You haven't sent me a copy of your "Notice of Asa Gray" at least I have never received one. Would be most pleased to though. We are having a very mild winter up here, the mercury has not been below 0° (F) ^{only} twice and both times during night or after sunset time. I collected 3 flowers of *Thuja occidentalis* in full bloom on the 14 (St. Valentine's Day) of this month! This is about ^{nearly} two months earlier than usual.
