Come on here (N<sup>o</sup> 101 Franklin St) at  
once from the train, <sup>or boat</sup> & you shall  
have such entertainment as



we can offer and glad to have  
you too - Our position is pretty  
central for Railways &c, being  
far down town - & if you  
remain over night, you shall  
have a well aired bed & we  
will get Carey down. I shall  
at any rate let him know  
of your being here in the daytime  
but his son is to be married  
next week, & possibly the days  
may clash.

The Philadelphians, changed  
their minds: & would not have  
me - so I came on here straight  
from Washn. - I have  
got for you the 2<sup>d</sup> Ed. <sup>my</sup> of "Manual"

which I was going to send on,  
but shall now keep till you  
call for it. It is a great improve-  
ment (in the outward at least)  
over the first edition.

I have taken my passage  
in the "Atlantic" (Collins line)  
to sail from this on 27<sup>th</sup> Inst.  
I hope to be at home before  
10<sup>th</sup> May, in time to send out  
cards for Conversazioni 24<sup>th</sup>
